



# MCC Scavenger Hunt



Welcome to the first MCC Photographic Scavenger Hunt.

Your goal today is to:

1. Take photos that match the topics you have been given
2. Make those photos as clever/interesting as possible
3. Have fun!

Timeline for today:

- Meet for initial briefing: 9:30am Sunday @ MCC building, South Melbourne
- Official kick-off: 10am
- Finishing line check-in: 3:30pm @ O'Connell's Centenary Hotel, corner of Montague and Coventry Sts, South Melbourne. We have a room booked.
- Judging and scoring: 4-6pm over beers at the pub

Images will be submitted digitally at the end of the day and then they will be assessed by the group on this basis:

- "Um, what's that supposed to be?" - 0 points
- "Okay, I guess that matches the topic." – 5 points
- "Hey, that's an interesting shot, I like it." - 10 points
- "That's an amazing/great/fantastic shot!" - 15 points

Every team has been given the same list of topics. This is not a race.

For scoring, quality will be preferred over quantity. Winners for the day will receive no prize other than the satisfaction of a job well done. All images must be taken during the day (so no sneaking home for *"here's one I prepared earlier"*).

You should shoot in a team of 2-4 people. You can split up if you like but that won't be as much fun and could make at least one item on the list difficult to achieve. Each team can submit only one image per topic.

Things to watch out for...

- It is likely you will be asked "what the hell are you doing?" by some random stranger today. Feel free to explain the concept and show them this information sheet.
- If you are asked to leave any privately owned/operated premises by the management/security (eg. Vic Markets), you should do so quietly and promptly.
- Please respect the privacy of others. Where possible, seek the permission of anyone you would like to take a photo of and respect the wishes of those who do not want their photo taken.
- Allow yourself time for a lunch break.
- Do not speed, trespass or otherwise act in a way that is likely to cause you grief.
- Allow yourself sufficient time for your return journey to be back at the pub by 3:30pm.
